### Functions:

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**• Button Functions****MENU**

1. Press this button to turn on the digital album
2. Depress for several minutes to shut down
3. Access the Control functions

**UP**

1. Press this button to browse the picture from last or to browse the picture on forward.

**DOWN**

2. Press this button to browse the picture from first or to browse the picture on backward.

USB interface: for picture downloads and battery charging

RESET key: press reset key to restart the digital keychain and restore to factory setting.

★ When the battery energy is low, the digital album will display "Low Power", please connect the digital album to the PC USB port to charge the battery immediately.

### How to Browse pictures.



- Depress MENU button for several seconds to enter Mode menu list. The menu includes: OFF, Display mode, Clock Set, Automatic switch ON/OFF, Clock Display, LCD Contrast, Delete, Exit.
- Hold MENU key to start the machine. Up-down button browse the picture. (Picture)
- You can set manual browse or automatic browse. Automatic browse can direct browse all pictures individually.
- If no file in the photo frame, it will display it as below:

**MENU Functions:**

**Press MENU button to access menu setup (picture)**



Depress the Up or Down button will scroll the option list. After you make your choice, press MENU button to confirm this option.

**1. Turn off (picture)**

- a. Press Up or Down buttons and scroll to OFF,
- b. Press MENU button to confirm.




**2. Display mode:**



- a. Operation the Display mode
- b. Select the Display mode: press MENU button to access, press Up or Down to select
- c. Choose Automatic mode: press MENU to access, scroll up or down to adjust time. Press MENU to return to main menu list.
- d. Select Automatic mode: you can automatically preview the picture according to the set up time.
- e. Select the Manual mode: press MENU to withdraw. You can control the preview picture with the Up and Down buttons.

3. **Clock set** (picture)



- a. Clock setup: Go to the main menu
- b. Select the Clock Set in the option list.
- c. Press MENU to Access
- d. You can use MENU button to change the values for YEAR, MONTH, DAY, SECOND, WEEK. Scroll the Up and Down buttons to increase or decrease the values.
- e. Press MENU button to return to main menu.


**4. Auto on/off**

- a. Auto on/off setting, this function allows you to turn On and Off the Digital Album on its own.
- b. Press MENU to access main menu
- c. Select Auto ON/OFF on the option list
- d. You can set the Auto ON/OFF to ON or OFF.
- e. When set to ON, the auto on time and the auto off time can be set. These 2 sets of values cannot be the same.
- f. Scroll Up and Down button to adjust the time values
- g. Press MENU again to exit the setup and return to main menu
- h. You cannot set the time when the Auto ON/OFF mode is set to off.

**5. Clock Disp**

- a. Setup for the Clock display on the LCD
- b. Select Clock Disp, press MENU button to access
- c. Set the Disp Clock to Normal. It will display the clock

- d. Set the Disp Clock to Water Mark. The clock information will display superimpose on the viewed images.

- a. Brightness adjustment  
b. Select Contrast from the main menu, press MENU to access  
c. Adjust contrast value with the Up and Down buttons; the brightness range values from 0 – 9.  
d. Press MENU button again to return to main menu.



#### 7. Exit:


Select Exit, press MENU button to return to display mode

## Connect computer

Please disable any anti-virus, anti-adware or anti-spam software before installing the driver software, PhotoViewer. The anti-adware software tend to wrongly identify the driver as an adware and prevent proper installation. After installation, you can enable the anti-adware software again.

### Install the Photo Viewer software into PC


1. Put the CD driver into the PC, go into "My Computer" and double-click the CD driver, such as D:(like below)




2. Double-click the Photo View Setup



3. Click Next




4. Click Next again




5. Choose the drive which you want to install in, such as C:/, click next




6. Click Next again to continues the installation

### Download the Pictures to Photo Display

1. Collect your photo frame to the computer with USB cable correctly.
2. The screen will show out "Power" and "USB Update", press **UP** or **DOWN** to select "USB Update".
3. Press **MENU** to enter "USB Update"
4. Double-click the photo viewer icon on the desktop. After that, the photo viewer window will come out like below:

5. Find the photo which you want to transfer to photo frame, such as "d:photo"



6. Select the photo file, the red dot line is the maximum size can show in the photo frame:





7. Click  to synchronize to transfer the photo file into the photo frame.
